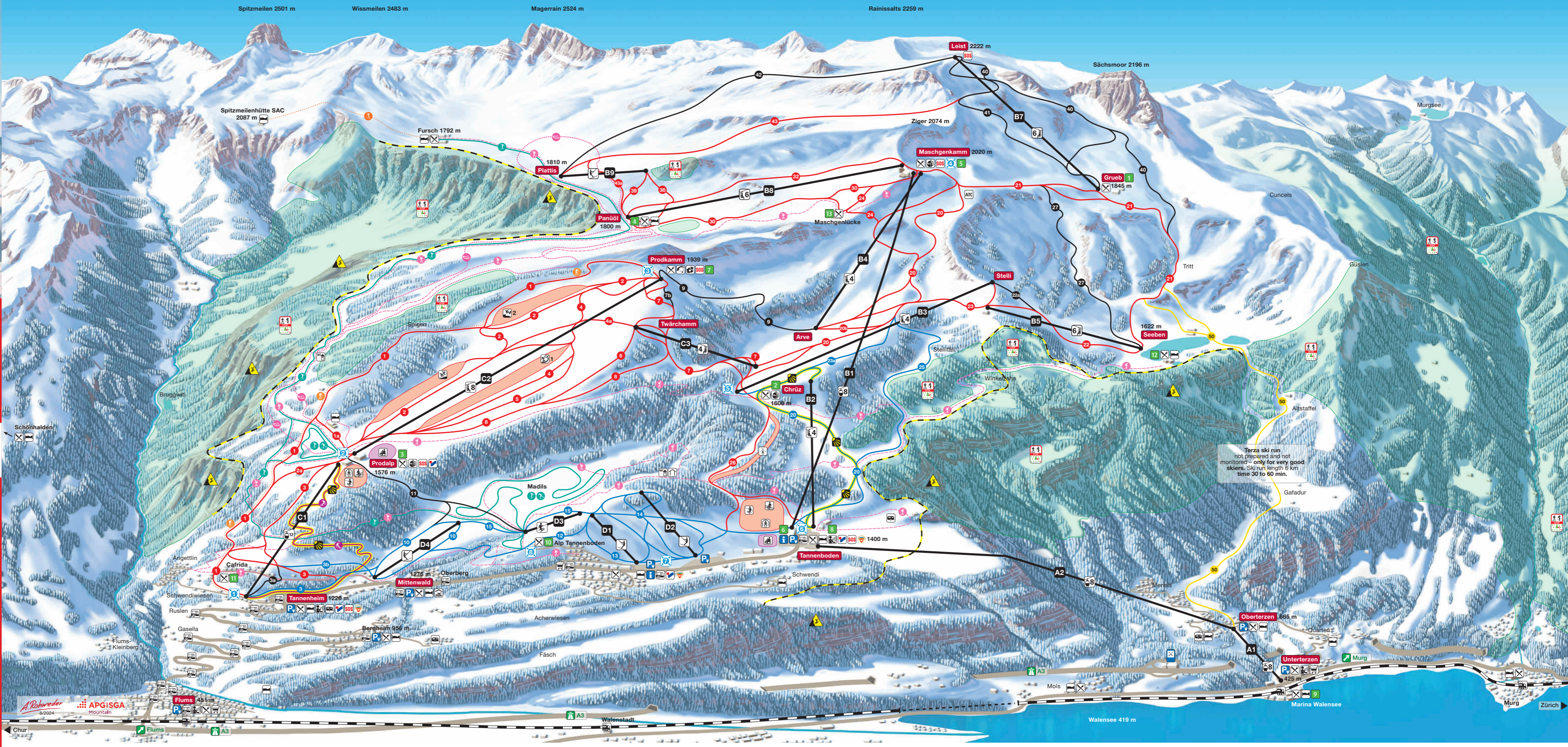
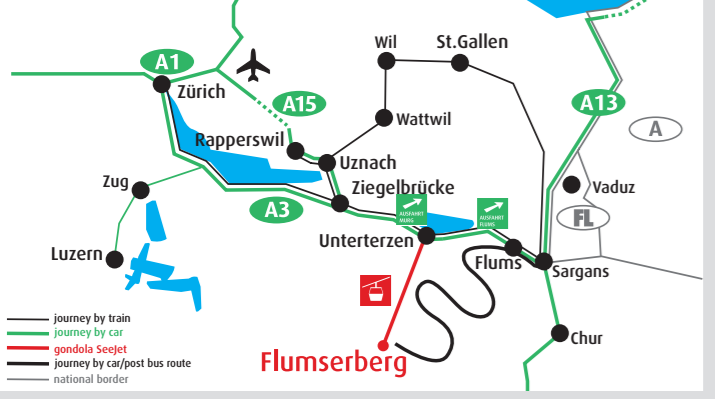

From home directly onto the slopes

S-Bahn: From mid-December 2024, the IR35 Aare Linth runs hourly and every day from Bern to Zurich Main station and on to Chur, stopping at Unterterzen. The S17 from Rapperswil reaches Unterterzen hourly and every day directly in 37 minutes. From St. Gallen, the S4 has a direct connection to the S17 in Uznach. With the S25 and a change to the S17 in Ziegelbrücke you can also reach Unterterzen and the gondola Seejet. More about the S-Bahn connection: www.sbb.ch

Postauto: From Sargans station, the post bus takes you via Flums into the winter sports area. An even more convenient way to get to the ski slopes and then back home again.

Rules of behaviour

Please respect the FIS rules, signals and barriers. The slope and rescue service only monitors and controls marked and open slopes and runs. Bergbahnen Flumserberg AG expressly disclaims any liability. For safety reasons, the slopes may neither be walked on by pedestrians nor used by sledges.

Outside the railway operating hours, the slopes and runs are closed and not protected from any hazards such as avalanche dispersion or piste machines with cable winches or tillers.

Danger to life and limb!
Note the times of the last slope check. It is forbidden to use slopes and runs for ascents and descents that are closed or barred.

It is forbidden to drive or walk in the wildlife quiet zones marked in green. Violators will be fined and have their ticket taken away in accordance with the general terms and conditions.

What should I do in the event of an accident?
Contact the nearest lift or railway station or contact the SOS number +41 81 720 15 19. Be as precise as you can about the location of the person who had the accident.

A fee is charged for the rescue of winter sports enthusiasts who have had an accident. Searches are also subject to a fee and are at the expense of the person being searched.
